



## Facility Status Update – June, 17, 2020

Dear Members,

We want to send you another update on the MLRA facility status, and policy changes as a result of the evolving COVID -19 pandemic. On behalf of the MLRA team and the Board of Directors I would like to thank every member for your continued patience as we manage through this challenging time. I would also like to thank all of our members who have visited the facility already and been very respectful and complied with the guidelines and restrictions implemented for all of our safety. McKenzie Lake is a great community and the people are a big reason for that.

On May 20, 2020, the park and facility opened in stage 1 of Alberta's relaunch plan, and we are happy to announce that we are continuing to ease restrictions into stage 2. Management and the Board of Directors continue to review and amend policies and procedures based on the guidance of the Alberta Government and health authorities.

There are a number of changes effective immediately as we enter into stage 2 of our relaunch, including:

- The minimum age a member can enter the facility without a parent is back to 12 years old.
- The fishing pier is now open. Restrictions on numbers and time limits apply.
- The Beach volleyball courts are now open.
- Pickleball nets are now available to members.
- Activities and gatherings are now permitted with members of your [MLRA Member Cohort Group](#).

**Restrictions** that remain in place include:

- No guests.
- Showers remain closed.
- Cooking, preparing and sharing food is still Not permitted.
- MLRA boat and equipment rentals remain closed.
- Shelters and the Beach Club remain closed.
- The office remains open on an appointment basis.

MLRA member cohort groups are MLRA members who partner with other MLRA member households, to a maximum of 15 people. All members in cohorts must be completely committed to maintaining physical distancing from people outside their cohort group.

at any time and we will continue to update the website and post at the front entrance. Please review these documents prior to coming to the facility. Members are expected to comply with the restrictions and policies implemented for everyone's safety.

While there is still uncertainty with respect to the impacts of COVID-19, the safety and well-being of our members and employees remain top priority. We will continue to evaluate this complex and fluid situation and update our members accordingly. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and compliance.
