



Suspension of Membership Privileges

Suspension of membership privileges can only be determined by the General Manager or a staff member he has authorized.

- Members, who are not in compliance with the Association's Rules including those that relate to unsafe boating and inappropriate behavior, may have their membership privileges including access to all facilities, suspended.
 - The parent (s) of a suspended member under 18 years of age may be contacted by the General Manager.
- The length of suspension will be determined by the General Manager as hereunder.
- Guests, who are not in compliance with the Association's Rules including those that relate to unsafe boating and inappropriate behavior, will be asked to leave the facilities.
 - The member who signed in the guest may be subject to suspension.

Length of Suspension

- The length of suspension will be:
 - seven (7) days for a first offence;
 - thirty (30) days for a second offence if it has occurred within six (6) months of the first offence;
 - up to sixty (60) days for a third offence if it has occurred within twelve (12) months of the first offence.
- Members who are involved with alcohol related incidents will be suspended a minimum of 60 days for the first offence, and up to 1 year if a second offence occurs. Guests involved in alcohol related incidents will be suspended from the facility indefinitely.
- If in the opinion of the General Manager, the offence is considered serious in nature, the length of suspension will be determined by the General Manager after a review of the circumstances including any information provided by the City of Calgary Police.
- The length of suspension for members who, on a regular basis are not in compliance with the Rules will be determined on a case-by-case basis.
- Any member who is suspended (other than for non-payment of membership fees), will be required to meet with the General Manager or his representative prior to having membership privileges reinstated.
